

In the middle of the shopping mall, there is a large waterfall. It is a decoration for westerners, however it is a Fengshui feature for Asians



When you enter a Chinese or Vietnamese restaurant, you see a small waterfall with the water running. The sign of running water means that the business is to run well and smoothly



 If the tourists venture to the rooftop of the Marina Sands shopping mall, right on top of the waterfall area, they will see a huge sinking area where water is poured in and circles in a form of a large vortex creating the waterfall inside the shopping mall. The fengshui explanation is that the energies or monies are gathered from the outside and sucked into the shopping mall



In reality, the fast changing design pattern is to keep sending new data to the eyes of people so people become confused and forgetful.





For Chinese, the hotel has the shape of a dragon




Along the side of the hotel, there are 100 columns



These 100 columns are seen as 100 baby dragons with a pearl in their mouth along the belly of the mother dragon. The business should be great because the mother dragon is so fertile




 However, the main Fenghsui feature of the Pangu 7 Star Hotel is that the hotel is located on a straight line connecting the Forbidden city, the temple of Heaven, Tian An Men square, where are also located the Great Hall of People (the Chinese Congress), the seat of the Chinese Communist party, the Chung Nam Hai compound (seat of the Chinese government). This straight line area is called the Flying Dragon pathway




What does a straight line from Thai Hoa Palace point to? (map by Google)




What stays straight ahead of Thai Hoa palace, on the other side of the river? (map by Google)





The notorious Thua Phu prison started during colonial time (1899) and lasted during nationalist and communist time




From a Fengshui belief, the Thua Phua prison is a talisman which neutralized the divine mandate and the political powers of the Imperial City of Hue

Which major city of Vietnam which was at the forefront of the political, military and intellectual scene of Vietnam AND suffered the most destruction in the 20th century?


It happened in 1945, 1954, 1963, 1965, 1968, 1972, 1975, and after HUE, Vietnam










1st Important Reason

The reason is that the emperor claimed to be the son of heaven so he was the only one on earth (south) who could communicate with heaven (north). He was the communicator connecting heaven and earth which was symbolized as a connection between north (+, positive or duong) and south (-, negative or am)

 The Imperial city of Beijing is painted as the heaven on earth.



In the past, the **Dowager Empress** Cuxi (Tu Hi Thai Hau) was claimed to be the reincarnated Kwan Yin (Quan Am Tai The)




If the Lord Nguyen Hoang built the Kim Long palace on the north south axis, he would have been killed by the Trinh Lord because Lord Nguyen Hoang showed too early his political ambition to be king of Vietnam


If the north south axis orientation was not feasible for the Kim Long palace, then what was the next best alternative? The Nguyen Lords selected the South East axis. Why?

This is why the buildings or houses in Hue have a wooden front and a brick side to reflect away the afternoon heat











Is the North South Axis best for a Developing Fiefdom or an Aspiring Politician?



- Question: Is the North South Axis best for a developing fiefdom or an aspiring politician?
- Answer: Pointing north is pointing at the top of a career (noon or full sunlight), of a dynasty or of a business. The next step is only to go down. So for an ambitious politician, he would start some steps below in order to go higher. The goal is to AIM high. It is the same strategy when we buy stocks. We buy low and sell high. Nobody wish to buy stocks at its peak.

Pointing at the south east is looking towards an emerging and promising future




Why does an arrow going from the right lower corner to the left upper corner symbol a great progress in the future? This is a question of old and modern marketing


First example

These 2 graphs show the sale of companies or countries. If you look from far away, which graph shows greater sale?






Does the presenter of this graph want to say that Russia is the worst or China is the best?






For Europeans or Americans, this graph shows that the sale in Russia is the worst





For Chinese readers, this graph emphasizes that China is the best, because the Chinese read from right to left and the arrow shows from the right lower corner to the left upper corner (the south east corner in the Bagua map)



Second example: This ad is for Americans so the view is from left to right and the message inciting women to buy this watch is at the end (right side)

Message: Sac dep, thanh lich la mot vu khi trong xa hoi va chinh tri. Vi vay minh phai mua no, de chung ta tro thanh powerful



Third example: This ad is for Chinese (Chinese characters and model) so the view is from right to left and the message inciting women to buy this watch is at the left side. The message is: If you like it, buy it



Fourth example: The cartoon below is for American. So the main focus of the cartoon is on the right side: a tall woman. The cartoon on the left is for Chinese on the China Daily: So the cartoon starts from the right and ends on the left. The main obsession, an European woman is at the left end





The Bagua Map has the North at the bottom and the South on the Top. WHY?







This is the earth as we see on regular photos




Now we talk about the magnetic field of the earth. The earth is like a large dynamo with an inner core of iron. Around it, there are strong currents moving around and creating the magnetic field of the earth


EARTH'S INNER CORE CURRENTS




This magnetic field protects the earth from the lethal radiation of the sun



We knew about this magnetic field only after the satellites in the 1950s could verify the presence of the magnetic field from space







However, if we look at the earth as a large dynamo, then we could present the inner core of the earth as a magnet. At this moment, the north side of the magnet is located in the south pole. The next slide is taken from a American website teaching physics to students





If the Bagua map wants to show how the world or the earth is functioning as a large dynamo with an inner core magnet, then the Bagua map is correct



How did the people in the antiquities (more than 3000 years ago) know about the principle of magnetism and draw a map with the north at the bottom and the south on the top? The Bagua map is the functional map of the magnet core inside the earth.


• In today's physics, the conventional agreement is for a magnet, the end which the magnetic field enters is called south and the end where the magnetic field exits is called north.



 Because the magnetic field enters the north pole and exits at the south pole so the huge magnet inside the earth should have its north pole in the south of the geographic earth



Did the Vietnamese people know about this principle?



- Did the ancient Vietnamese people know about this principle? I believe so.
- In today's physics, the conventional agreement is for a magnet, the pole which the magnetic field enters is called south and the pole where the magnetic field exits is called north.
- The day to day Vietnamese language has an expression: Vao nam ra bac. Where does it come from? Does it have any connection with the current principle of going in and out of a magnetic field on a magnet?




Now I have a more complex scientific question on the Bagua map. Have you ever seen a Bagua map with the north on top and the south at the bottom?

This Bagua map has the north on its top and the south on its bottom



What is the difference between these 2 maps?





The difference is that one is of tien thien and the other one is of hau thien. Can we explain this difference with the earth magnetic field?

- 800,000 years ago, the earth's magnetic field has flipped its polarity so the large magnet inside the earth has its north end at the geographic north pole like in the Tien Thien Bat Quai. Here is the reference from the NASA website




Now the Imperial City is looking to the North West: It is not well balanced like the Dong Ba market




Now the Imperial City is positioned on the other side of the river, looking towards the North West, is the location good?






 Another very important Buddhist temple is the Tu Dam pagoda.




This is the Phu Cam Church






What happened in the past 500 years on the land between the Gia Vien island and the Ngu Binh mountain?

In 1470, King Le Thanh Ton came to suppress an uprising of the Cham people. Many were killed





